Re: Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) Consultation for the Synergy Resources proposed variance request to Rule 603.a.(2) Form 2A #400039627 in Weld County

Dear Mr. Neslin:

This letter describes CDPHE's decision to recommend that the COGCC grant the request for a variance to COGCC Rule 603.a.(2) submitted by Synergy Resources. Rule 603a.(2) establishes a minimum distance a well shall be located from a property line and states in part:

"A well shall be a minimum distance of one hundred fifty (150) feet from a surface property line..."

Facts learned during consultation include:

- Synergy Resources is requesting approval to locate a well 151 feet from a surface property line; and
- The distance was confirmed through a review of the Well Location Certificate included in the Form 2 application submittal.

In view of the foregoing and after verifying the distance to the surface property line is greater than 150 feet; CDPHE believes that no variance is necessary. CDPHE reserves the right to consult on any future variance requests from rules this agency may consult on (pursuant to COGCC Rule 306) within this location.
