As we have discussed by phone and email exchanges recently, East Cheyenne Gas Storage, LLC (ECGS) is planning to implement an alternative remediation work plan for the above-captioned project, pursuant to your February 2, 2010 letter that responded to our Form 27 submittal.

We have prepared a revised work plan for your review that includes some of the same work elements as those in the previous work plan attached to our Form 27 on January 7, 2010 that relate to pit excavation, backfilling and closure. The revised work plan provides a technical basis for landfarm, treatment of the hydrocarbon-affected materials at the site. Attachment 1 provides complete details on the remediation work plan and the design, operation, and monitoring of the proposed landfarm.
