Dear Mr. Warren,

This email is intended to confirm that we had a telephone conversation this morning to engage in the required CDOW Wildlife Consultation process regarding the proposed Chevron C-19 596 well pad (Form 2A - 400054116), proposed by Berry Petroleum Company.

In an effort to mitigate potential impacts to sage grouse and wildlife species in general, Berry Petroleum will enter into a Wildlife Mitigation Agreement with Chevron, the surface owner. The Wildlife Mitigation Agreement will identify requirements related to Berry's activities, the installation of surface equipment, reclamation and revegetation of disturbed areas, and offsite sage grouse habitat improvement.

Berry Petroleum believes that the implementation of the Wildlife Mitigation Agreement with the surface owner will significantly reduce and mitigate potential adverse impacts to sage grouse and other wildlife species.
