Wayne,

I have been reviewing the Bruton 30-10 Pad **Form 2A** (#400075437). COGCC requests the following clarifications regarding the data Laramie Energy II has submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

1. **General:** Due to the potentially permeable nature of the surface materials in this area (Wasatch Formation), the following conditions of approval (COAs) will apply:
  - COA 9** - Any pit constructed to hold fluids must be lined, or a closed loop drilling system must be implemented.
  - COA 38** - The moisture content of any drill cuttings in a cuttings pit, trench, or pile shall be as low as practicable to prevent accumulation of liquids greater than de minimis amounts. At the time of closure, the drill cuttings must also meet the applicable standards of table 910-1.
  - COA 44** - The access road will be constructed as to not allow any sediment to migrate from the access road to the nearby surface water (Horse Gulch) or any drainages leading to surface water.

COGCC would appreciate your concurrence with attaching these COAs to the Form 2A permit prior to passing the OGLA review. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call me at (970) 309-2514 (cell), or email. Thanks.
