Surface is owned by the Federal Government. This Location Assessment is for expansion of the existing SR 33-9 well pad. There are currently 4 producing wells on the pad. The plans are to drill an additional 13 wells. The location reference point for this location is the existing SR 33-9 well from which all measurements were made. Reference photos will be provided at a later date. Williams will employ the following BMP's to support protection of surface and ground water. 1) Williams will ensure 110% secondary containment for fluids contained at well site during drilling and completion operations. 2) Williams will implement best management practices to contain unintentional release of fluids. 3) A closed loop mud system will be used

**CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL, IF ANY:**

**All representations, stipulations and conditions of approval stated in this Form 2A for this location shall constitute representations, stipulations and conditions of approval for any and all subsequent operations on the location unless this Form 2A is modified by Sundry Notice, Form 4 or an Amended Form 2A.**

The location is in an area of high run off/run-on potential; therefore the pad shall be constructed to prevent any stormwater run-on and/or stormwater runoff.

Reserve pit (or any pit that will hold liquids [if constructed]) must be lined or closed loop system (which has been indicated by Williams on the Form 2A) must be implemented during drilling.

Operator must ensure 110 percent secondary containment for any volume of fluids contained at well site during drilling and completion operations; including, but not limited to, construction of a berm or diversion dike, diversion/collection trenches within and/or outside of berms/dikes, site grading, or other comparable measures sufficiently protective of nearby surface water. If fluids are conveyed via pipeline, operator must implement best management practices to contain any unintentional release of fluids.

The moisture content of any drill cuttings in a cuttings pit, trench, or pile shall be as low as practicable to prevent accumulation of liquids greater than de minimis amounts. At the time of closure, the drill cuttings must also meet the applicable standards of table 910-1.

No portion of any pit that will be used to hold liquids shall be constructed on fill material, unless the pit and fill slope are designed and certified by a professional engineer, subject to review and approval by the director prior to construction of the pit. The construction and lining of the pit shall be supervised by a professional engineer or their agent. The entire base of the pit must be in cut.
