Alex:

The second round of samples were taken October 4, 2010 and I hope to see results Thursday or Friday. After BOPCO's own site visit and photo documentation of the spill area we met with Ed Winters (DOW) on October 5, 2010. Based on the produced water release from the underground pipeline we told Ed that BOPCO did discuss treating the soil in place with Olsson Associates. We experience no smell of hydrocarbon when walking the spill area. Olsson Associates indicated this area may be "ideal for a bioremediation enhancing amendment" and indicated that "mixing gypsum into the soil will decrease the amount of soil dispersion caused by the sodium". BOPCO feels this is the way to go and hopefully the second sampling results will show decreased levels of TPH, benzene, and SAR. I have attached 7 photos of the area. I will let you know once I hear from the Corp.
