All representations, stipulations and conditions of approval stated in this Form 2A for this location shall constitute representations, stipulations and conditions of approval for any and all subsequent operations on the location unless this Form 2A is modified by Sundry Notice, Form 4 or an Amended Form 2A.

Operator must implement site-specific best management practices in accordance with good engineering practices, including, but not limited to, construction of a berm or diversion dike, site grading, or other comparable measures, sufficient to protect the irrigation ditch located 67 feet south and the pond located 174 feet east of the proposed oil and gas location from a release of drilling, completion, produced fluids, and chemical products.

Operator must notify COGCC Field Inspector Ed Binkley 48 hours prior to pad construction to give the Field Inspector an opportunity to inspect the operator's measures to protect the irrigation ditch located 67 feet south of the proposed oil and gas location.
