Dear Mr. Schneider:

As you are aware, the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) has previously provided Kerr McGee Rocky Mountain Corporation (KM) with a list of former Amoco facilities where prior operations have reportedly impacted or threatened to impact shallow ground waters. KM has reviewed this list and submitted a table listing each site with recommendations for COGCC staff to consider. The list contains the following sites:

- 1) Six of the sites have been plugged and abandoned. All of these sites with the exception of the Mathisen Unit #2 will be considered closed.
- 2) Five of these sites are currently operated by Noble Energy Production, Inc. and are not included.
- 3) Closure was granted to the Donald Vynckier GU #1 site on 4/22/05 (Remediation #3386).

KM has proposed closure for Recommendations for closure at

There are a total of 23 sites that are recommended for further action. Based on recent developments, the Carl Adler B site will also require further action. Therefore, KM shall submit a Form 27 – Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan for each of these sites. Workplans have already been submitted for the following sites:

- Floyd C. Shaw Unit #1 Remediation #1793
- John Dittirro GU #1 Remediation #3289
- Helmer Getz Unit #1 Remediation #3509
- Paul B Schmidt GU #1 Remediation #3541
- Keith Carter A Unit #1 Remediation #3643
