Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the remediation documentation for these sites:


- NW Arapahoe Tank Battery, Sec 32, T13S R42W, Spill Report #200100910, incident on 12/28/2006
- Schuntz Tank Battery, Sec. 30, T13S R43W, Spill Report #1445894, incident on 6/17/2005
- NW AU#2 Tank Battery, Sec. 25, T13S R43W, Spill Report #1230508, incident on 2/15/2005

Based on review of this information, COGCC requires no further action at this time at these locations.

For future reference, beneficial re-use of contaminated soil on-site is **not** allowed until COGCC Table 910 standards have been met by treatment. Please refer to the May 1, 2009 COGCC Amended Rules Series 900 as necessary for requirements regarding spill reporting, remediation and sampling guidelines.
