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Margaret,

I am attaching the odor complaint info to this e mail chain. The complaint came from Bonnie Smeltzer who left a message on the rifle complaint line on Thursday evening and also on Friday evening, also she left a voice mail message on my cell phone on Thursday evening. I spoke with Mrs Smeltzer at 11am on Saturday. Mrs. Smeltzer stated that she noticed an odor described as an "Industrial odor" and that her eyes watered and she needed to use eye drops to relief the burning and watering. Mrs. Smeltzer thought that the odor was coming from a flare stack on the Watson ranch pad, and drove there to observe and photograph the flare stack. Mrs. Smeltzer also mentioned that a neighbor was experiencing some type of skin irritation and thought that this may also be associated with activity at the Watson ranch pad.

I was unable to detect any odor associated with the Watson ranch pad on Friday or Saturday evening. Jon Black stated that Jen Maddox from the Colorado Department of Health was also on the location during the evening. I am not able to find any violations that may be contributing to the physical problems that Mrs. Smeltzer has expressed concern with.
