Ladies/Gentlemen:

Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP (KMG) respectfully requests the Director grant an exception to Rule 603 a. (2) to allow the above referenced oil and gas wells to be drilled at the above described location which is closer than 150 feet from the nearest property line.

Rule 603 a (2) of the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission's Rules and Regulations requires a well to be drilled at least 150 feet from a surface property line. Per Article 2 (Well Locations) of the Surface Use Agreement dated October 14, 2004, KMG has obtained permission to place the wells at the exception location. Thank you for your consideration.
