Railroad is 2.4 +/- miles away from site. There are no visible improvements within 400 feet of site. Nearest water well 2,475.5 +/- feet from site (RECEIPT: 0493774B; PERMIT: 241965-A; USE: DOMESTIC STOCK). The location is in a sensitive area due to being within the Northern High Plains Designated Basin. No COAs are needed for this location. A Pump Jack may be necessary to place on facility in the future to help with gas production. It will require either one gas or one electric motor to run the pumping jack unit which will be determined at the time of installation.
