In accordance with the Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission's (COGCC) rules, please be advised Merit Energy Company [MEC] plans to begin subsequent well operations on the above referenced well within 30 days.

Rule 305.e. (4) Notice of subsequent well operations. This rule states, that an operator shall provide to the surface owner or agent at least seven (7) days advance notice of subsequent well operations with heavy equipment that will materially impact surface areas beyond the existing access road or well site, such as recompletion or re-fracturing of the well.

If applicable, please notify your tenant farmer or lessee of this activity.


