Please find attached a supplemental Form 27 and supporting documentation for the subject site located in the NWNW Section 11 – T6N – R65W. A Form 19 was submitted on 10/21/09 (Spill #1632793) and an initial Form 27 was submitted on 4/2/2010 (Remediation #4935). Approx. 253 cubic yards of impacted soil was removed for offsite disposal. Additionally, an unknown volume of impacted groundwater was also recovered from the open excavation. Lab results of confirmation soil samples were below Table 910-1 Concentration Levels.

Subsequently, three groundwater monitoring wells were installed. Lab results indicate four consecutive quarters of groundwater monitoring with non-detectable BTEX concentrations. As a result, PDC is requesting No Further Action at this spill/release site.
