## **Proposed Best Management Practices Summary**

In accordance with Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment General Permit No. COR-039527, storm water management plans (SWMP) are in place to address construction, drilling and operations associated with Oil and Gas Development. Accordingly, BMP's used will vary according to the location and project phase and will be modified in accordance with the SWMP.

Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) plans are in place for production facilities as regulated by CFR 112.

Site maintenance will consist of neat and orderly storage of material and fluids. All waste will be stored and disposed of in accordance with applicable regulations. If a spill does occur, prompt cleanup will be performed to minimize any commingling of waste materials with storm water runoff. Routine maintenance will be limited to fueling and lubrication of equipment. Drip pans will be used during routine maintenance and fueling to contain spills and/or leaks. Any waste products from maintenance will be placed in containers and transported offsite for disposal or recycling. ALL overhauls conducted will be OFFSITE.

Trash and cleanup of the drill site will be completed on a daily basis. This cleanup will consist of patrolling the roadway, access areas, and other work areas to pick up trash, scrap debris, other discard material, and any contaminated soil. All debris will be disposed of properly.
