Hi Liz,

The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A oil and gas location assessment for the NESLON SW-32 well pad location in the NWSW Sec32 T7N R66W, Weld County, and requests Petroleum Development Corporation's approval of the following changes to the Form 2A:

- 1) **Access Road Map:** COGCC Rules require that the Access Road Map be submitted on a topographic base map. This allows for a review of whether the access road crosses any riparian or wetland areas. Please submit a revised Access Road Map that includes a topographic map as its base. [ATTACHED](#)
- 2) **Water Resources:** The location is in a sensitive area due to the likelihood of shallow ground water and the proximity to the creek. Therefore, please approve me changing the Sensitive Area Designation from No to Yes. [APPROVED](#)
- 3) **Condition of Approval:** To be protective of the creek located 98 feet east of the proposed location, the following condition of approval will apply to this Form 2A: "Operator must implement site-specific best management practices in accordance with good engineering practices, including, but not limited to, construction of a berm or diversion dike, site grading, or other comparable measures, sufficient to protect the creek located 98 feet east of the oil and gas location from a release of drilling, completion, produced fluids, and chemical products."
