Jay,

Last April Bobby Coslett at Windsor sent me Notices of Intent and Subsequent reports of plugging for the Tranco 1 and 2. Apparently, Starlight Resources, Windsor's predecessor in interest had partially completed the forms, but failed to submit them to anyone. We sent an inspector out to look at the wells, and they are definitely plugged. We accepted the forms as is, although the Subsequent Notice for the Tranco 2 is still pending until they replace the marker with something legible. I did fax copies of the forms to your state office when this came up last summer.

Tranco 2C was plugged in April 2009, upon discovery by one of our inspector that, even though the reclamation had been done, the plugging operation had not been completed. I just checked our records and discovered that we still don't have the SR. I just e-mailed Bobby to request it. The following was written by Bud Thompson, one of our inspectors.

Met with D. Pittman(Windsor Representative), to complete abandonment of well Tranco 2C.. Well had been previously filled with shale to within 50' of surface but final cement plug had not been poured. On 4/1/09 filled 50' of csg with 14# cement(approx 3/4 yd). Informed Pittman to let set overnite and would return next day to see if cement fell. On 4/2/09 observed that cement had fallen less than 1' so Pittman topped off with approx 1 sk cement, cut csg 3' below surface, welded on ID plate with appropriate information and backfilled hole. No further action. GPS'd location with the following coordinates::: 40.07458682N & 108.76879755
