Upon talking with the surveyor, from the Kerry # 5 well stake to the North and East side of the well pad approximately 200' there is a one foot rise in elevation. From the North edge of the well pad to the South edge unnamed creek is flat with a drop in elevation to the bottom of the creek.

For the Kerry # 5, Form 2A / COA. Wiepking-Fullerton Energy, L.L.C. (W-F) will place a 6" berm on the North and East side of the well pad with a slit fence.

The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A (#40142960,) for the Wiepking-Fullerton Energy Kerry #5 location, located in the NWNE Sec 20 T10S R55W Lincoln, Colorado. The COGCC requests the following changes regarding the data submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

1. COAs: Due to the close proximity of an unnamed drainage 136' North of the proposed location the following COA will apply.

Operator must implement site-specific best management practices in accordance with good engineering practices, including, but not limited to, construction of a berm or diversion dike, site grading, or other comparable measures, sufficient to protect the unnamed drainage 136 feet North of the oil and gas location from a release of drilling, completion, produced fluids, and chemical products.

The COGCC would appreciate your concurrence with the COA prior to passing the OGLA review. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
