Flare Stack to be removed after gas line installation. One of the two heater treaters will be removed when production volumes fall below the capacity of a single heater treater. Water Well information obtained from water well permit #49623, approximately 6600' to the SE of the proposed location Sec 11, T11N, R64W. Water well approximately 5854' to the E of the proposed location had no information available on the COGCC GIS. The reference area is to the northeast of the proposed location. The closed loop system utilized to drill the referenced well is a semi-closed loop system. Drilling mud and cuttings will be remediated prior to burial onsite.
