Further study by Kinder Morgan geologist determined that the GP-23 well was heading in the dirrection of a subsurface fault therefore KM has decided to change the directional plan for the BH location. Surface locations have remained the same as the original plan. For this change in drilling plans I have attached the following;

Revised drilling plan containing several changes including rev. well bore diagram, BH location, directional plan revision and revised pages to include into the original plan correcting these changes.


Revised lease map showing the new BH location lease
