The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A (#400157675) for the Mcelvain Oil & Gas Properties Pyramid 13-1 location, located in the NENE Sec 13 T2S R47W Yuma County, Colorado. The COGCC requires the following changes regarding the data submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

1. Construction: The "Will salt (>15,000 ppm TDS Cl) or oil based muds be used" tab is checked yes.
 - Please confirm that salt > 15,000 ppm or oil based mud will be used during drilling.
2. Sensitive Area: The proposed location falls within the Northern High Plains Designated basin and therefore is considered a sensitive area.
 - The Sensitive Area Tab is required to be changed to Yes.
