Hi Janice,

The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A oil and gas location assessment for the CLAYMON 843-6-32-L10 well location in Lot10 Sec6 T8N R43W, Phillips County, and requests the following changes and clarifications to the Form 2A.

- 1) **Water Resources:** Water well permit 146748-A is located approximately 1,690 feet from the proposed location. Therefore, please approve me changing the distance to nearest water well to 1,690 feet. I concur with the change.
- 2) **Access Road Maps:** It appears that the proposed access road crosses through a residence or ranch on the property. Can you clarify the access road route, and if necessary revise the Access Road Maps? Yes, it does cross through property. Per surface owner: "Road Access off of CR 51, drive way, follow south side of REA poles to field line west, then directly north into location."
