Hi Lisa,

The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A oil and gas location assessment for the MANENTI 20-54 well and tank battery location in the SESE Sec 20 T7N R66W, Weld County. Great Western has indicated the location is in a sensitive area. COGCC agrees with this assessment because the location is both in close proximity to the Eaton Canal and shallow ground water is likely present at the location.

Does Great Western have BMPs developed or a construction plan for the tank battery such that the operations will proactively reduce the likelihood of a spill causing significant impacts to ground water?
