The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A (#400161795) for the Noble Stewardson USX WW33-01D multi-well pad location, located in the NWNE Sec 33 T1N R66W Weld County, Colorado. The COGCC requests the following changes regarding the data submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

Sensitive Area Determination: Due to the presence of a domestic water well (Permit # 135478) within 1/8 of a mile the area is considered a sensitive area by rule.

- The Sensitive area determination is required be changed to yes.

COAS: Due to the canal to the south-southwest of the location the following will apply:

- Operator must implement site-specific best management practices in accordance with good engineering practices, including, but not limited to, construction of a berm or diversion dike, site grading, or other comparable measures, sufficient to protect the canal 198 feet west-southwest of the oil and gas location from a release of drilling, completion, produced fluids, and chemical products.
