Dear Mrs. Epperly and Mr. Young,

Enclosed is the laboratory analysis report for the water sample BBC's subcontractor collected from your domestic water well on April 4, 2011. Soraya Baroumand and I performed oversight of the sample collection on that date.

This laboratory report from BBC arrived in my email while I was on travel on May 23, 2011, which is the first time I received this information. The sample was analyzed for 104 volatile and semi-volatile compounds in addition to gasoline and diesel range organics, methane, as well as naturally occurring metals and inorganic compounds. Results from this sample from your water well indicate that no volatile and semi-volatile compounds were detected in your well water during the April sampling event.

The Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) will evaluate the water quality data from this water well sample, and will generate a letter discussing various inorganic constituents reported by the laboratory and what the concentrations identified in your water mean. The letter discussing the results of this water well sample relative to previous water well samples will be forthcoming.

BBC is reported to be preparing a letter to you containing this information also.
