I have been reviewing the MDP-25 Pad (SESW 33-691), 23A-33-691 **Form 2A** #400176870. COGCC would like to attach the following COAs for the proposed location based on the information and data Bill Barrett Corp has submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA) review.

1. **Multi-Well Pits:** The following conditions of approval (COAs) will apply:

COA 41 – A Form 15 Earthen Pit Permit must be submitted to the COGCC Location Specialist for Western Colorado (Dave Kubeczko; email dave.kubeczko@state.co.us) and approval must be obtained prior to construction of the multi-well pit.

COA 50 – The multi-well pit shall be closed in accordance with Rule 905. Closure of Pits, and Buried or Partially Buried Produced Water Vessels.

COGCC would appreciate your concurrence with attaching these COAs to the Form 2A permit prior to passing the OGLA review. In addition, could Bill Barrett provide COGCC with the COAs and wildlife stipulations that BLM has attached to this location.
