The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A (#400184491) for the King 12-28 location, located in the SWNW Sec 28 T19S R69W Fremont County, Colorado. The COGCC requests the following changes regarding the data submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

1. Multi-well plan: : Due to two well being placed on the pad the COGCC requires that a multi well plan be provided. The plan should show both the well head location and bottom hole location. Further information regarding multi well plans can be found in COGCC rule 303.d.3.I.
2. COAS: The location has COAs from the initial 2A that remain in effect. The COA for the location is as follows:
 - All pits must be lined or a closed loop system used.
