Subject Reassurance for COGCC of SUA Conference on 6 Fee
Lease Oil Wells Proposed on Pawnee National Grassland

Linda,

I understand COGCC requires proof of contact with the surface owner for proposed oil wells before they'll issue a permit. I understand also, if a bond is required by the surface owner, that that be taken care of, too.

For the following proposed oil and gas wells on Pawnee National Grassland:

Federal PC LG05-08: SE/4NE/4, Section 5, T. 8 N., R. 59 W., 6th P.M.
Federal PC LG06-07: SW/4NE/4, Section 6, T. 8 N., R. 59 W., 6th P.M.
Federal PC LG08-12: NW/4, SW/4, Section 8, T. 8 N., R. 59 W., 6th P.M.

please convey to COGCC that the US Forest Service is satisfied of Noble Energy's cooperation to provide the US Forest Service with all information needed at this time to analyze and permit the proposed wells. Also, please convey that we feel that Noble Energy is cooperating fully with us with regard to establishing a bond for reclamation of surface impacts for these proposed wells. The Forest Service will only require a bond to cover surface impacts. Whatever the State requires for downhole bonding will be considered adequate. As soon as the bond is posted and processed in accordance with Forest Service regulations and policy for all six proposed wells, COGCC will be notified and provided the appropriate documentation, if needed.
