Hi Erin,

The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A oil and gas location assessment for the BEVJAC ZP 10-1H well location in the NWNW Sec10 T11N R64W, Weld County, and requests clarification or changes of the following items:

- 1) **Drilling Mud:** The Form 2A indicates that salt or oil based mud will be used. Is this correct?
- 2) **Reference Area:** The statement regarding the reference area does not match the Reference Area Picture supplied. The reference area picture appears to be west of the location. Can you please clarify where the reference area is located?
- 3) **Location Pictures:** The Location Pictures are of poor resolution and very difficult to view. Please submit clear Location Pictures.
- 4) **Access Road Map and Hydrology Map:** The topographic base for the Access Road Map and Hydrology Map is nearly illegible. Do you have a better quality image for these maps?
- 5) **Water Resources:** The presence of nearby springs and the local topography as it relates to the Chalk Bluffs to the north indicate shallow ground water may be present at this location. Therefore, COGCC considers this a Sensitive Area and has changed the Sensitive Area Designation to Yes.

Note that the comments you provided regarding access road sharing, pad orientation and the production facility location are very helpful.
