

Subject: Final reclamation of the CBM wells and facilities on the Rohr Ranch

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Rohr

Thank you for meeting me at your ranch on 7/1/11 to consult on reclamation of the well sites and associated facilities on your property. During that meeting you informed me of which roads to keep "as is" and not reclaim. Those roads are marked with a dotted line on the attached map.

To be able to leave these roads "as is" the COGCC requires Petroglyph to request from the COGCC a variance of the 1000 series rules for final reclamation. The variance request needs to include an agreement between Petroglyph and the landowner concerning the final reclamation and, a specific use of the unclaimed facilities has to be defined in the variance. You have informed me you would like to keep the roads for the specific use of improved ranch access.
