Joan,

The following is an excerpt from your 10/05/2011 email:

Hells Gulch Federal 25-5, API 077-09399: Oxy received a Form 4 Sundry indicating that this well had been shut in for more than two years and was due to have an MIT performed. A subsequent Form 4 Sundry was sent to the COGCC and the BLM on 8/26/2011 explaining that this well changed from a shut-in status to a producing status effective 3/22/2011.

The first Sundry Notice that you are referring to, which required the MIT as a Condition of Approval, is Document No. 2055188 (received by COGCC on 01/31/2011 and approved by COGCC on 08/01/2011). I suspect that COGCC's production records were not up to date when we approved that Sundry Notice. Based on our current records, Hells Gulch Federal 25-5 returned to production in March 2011. Therefore, please disregard the MIT requirement on Sundry Notice, Document No. 2055188.

I did not personally receive the 8/26/2011 Sundry Notice, and as far as I can tell, it has not been data-entered or processed in COGCC's system. Unlike BLM, a Return to Production Sundry Notice is not required by COGCC. Our SI/TA tracking is based on the completion status reported by the operator monthly on production records.
