Mary,

I have been reviewing the Kaufman Pad #2 11A-25-692 Pad **Form 2A** (#400208684). The 317B Surface Water Supply Area's intermediate Buffer Zone Rules must be followed. COGCC has made the following changes and requests additional information prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA) review.

1. **Water Resources (Section 14):** Form 2A indicates the distance to the nearest surface water is 358 feet, making this a **sensitive area**. COGCC has made this change.
2. **Water Resources (Section 14):** Form 2A indicates the depth to groundwater to be 115 feet bgs for a well located 289 feet from the proposed well pad, making this a **sensitive area**. COGCC's review of several nearby water wells indicated that the depth to groundwater in this area is approximately 30' to 60' bgs based on a well to the northwest and a Kaufman well to the northeast. COGCC has made this change.
3. **Rule 303.A.:** A minimum of four (4) color photographs, one (1) of the staked location from each cardinal direction. Each photograph shall be identified by: **date taken**, well or location name, and direction of view. No date given; therefore, the date the pictures were taken is needed.

4. **Rule 303.F.ii.bb.:** Four (4) color photographs of the reference area, taken during the growing season of vegetation and facing each cardinal direction. Each photograph shall be identified by **date taken**, well or oil and gas location name, and direction of view. No date given; therefore, the date the pictures were taken is needed.
5. **Rule 303.d.(3).C.:** Neither the scaled Construction Layout Drawings nor the Location Drawing show the location of the proposed gas and water pipelines. One or both of these drawings should show the anticipated locations of these new facilities or a statement indicating that the pipelines will follow the access road would be sufficient.

COGCC would appreciate the issues outlined in items 3, 4, and 5 be addressed prior to permit approval. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call me at (970) 309-2514 (cell), or email. Thanks.
