Ladies & Gentlemen:

Walker Energy holds an oil and gas lease covering lands in which you own the surface. Pursuant to Rule 305 of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, this letter is to give you notice that Petron Development Company (operator for the property) intends to conduct operations for drilling of a Niobrara gas well. Pursuant to Rule 305 (e)(1)(A) a list of major equipment components includes, but may not be limited to: Drilling Rig with Diesel Engine, Catwalk, Doghouse with Diesel Engine, Mud Tank, Mud Pump with Diesel Engine, Water Tankers, Tractors with Diesel Engines, Travel Camper, Trash Trailer, Portable Toilet, Storage Trailer, wellhead[Christmas tree], flow line & water line, meter shed and associated metering equipment.
4. Pursuant to Rule 305 (e)(1)(A) attached is a drawing showing all visible improvements within (400') four hundred feet of the proposed location. [see attached exhibit]
5. Pursuant to Rule 305 (e)(1)(A) an 8-1/2" x 11" vicinity or U.S. Geological Survey map showing the access road into location. [see attached exhibit]

6. Pursuant to Rule 305 (e)(I)(A), be advised that the complete Permit Application will be available on the COGCC web site at <http://cogcc.state.co.us> for your review and the submittal of comment to the Director should you desire to do so.
7. Enclosed is a brochure describing surface owner rights and responsibilities from the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission along with rules and procedures concerning a request for an onsite inspection from the C.O.G.C.C.
8. In addition, we have enclosed a return addressed, postage prepaid envelope upon which you (the surface owner) may request your preference with respect to a consultation with the operator under Rule 306. Please include the attached election form.
9. The surface owner has responsibility for notifying any affected tenant of the proposed operations.
