The COGCC requests the following changes regarding the data submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

Facilities

As per our previous email regarding mud disposal I suggest amending the method of disposal to Evaporation and Burial. **Petron concurs.**

Sensitive Area Determination

Because the location falls within the Northern High Plains Designated Area the Sensitive Area tab will be amended to yes. **Petron concurs.**

Land use

Reviews of the aerial photographs indicate that the land use probably is best described as Dry land. I suggest amending the 2A current and future land use to "Dry Land". **Petron concurs.**
