Kallasandra,

The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A (#400222180) for the Petron Development Company YCO 13-10 location, located in the NENE Sec 10 T4N R46W Yuma County, Colorado. The COGCC requests the following changes regarding the data submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

Sensitive Area Determination

Because the location falls within the Northern High Plains Designated Area the Sensitive Area tab will be amended to yes. **That is fine.**

Distance to nearest surface water

Reviews of the aerial photographs indicate that there is a pond/canal located approximately 320 feet south west of the location. The distance to surface water should be changed to 320 feet. No COAs will result in this change.

For the YCO 12-10 and 13-10, the pond/canal the COGCC is referring to is, in fact, an intermittent stream. It flows/retains water about one time in two to three year periods in the heaviest of rains for an extremely short time. The surface owners in the area (nor the County) do not recognize it as any kind of body of water. Roadways have been built over it without the use of culverts or other water considering devices. Petron does not believe this should be changed.
