This well was approved in late December of last year. However, upon review today it was noted that this horizontal well drilling from the NENW to the SESW of the section passes within 14 feet of a mapped J Sand test that was plugged in 1957. Its exact whereabouts is probably not known and the possibility that a well collision could occur. We are alerting you to this fact if you have not already identified the well and its potential for an accident. Please respond to this email to acknowledge that you are aware and that you will take the necessary actions to avoid collision.
