Dear Mr. Neslin:

Please let this letter serve as a request for the omission of open hole logs. The COGCC has acknowledged that a cement bond log will be accepted in lieu of open hole logs on every well as long as Kerr-McGee logs up into the surface. The cement bond log will be logged above the depth of the surface casing shoe on all wells that do not have open hole logs run in order to satisfy the state's request. Kerr-McGee will continue to submit open hole logs on each well that they are run on, per the COGCC requirements. The Form 5 will list all open hole logs run, or if none were run, it will be clearly stated on the Form 5.
