Dear Mr. Neslin:

Marathon Oil Company ("Marathon") is proposing to drill the Crow Valley 7-62-23-2H and 7-62-14-2H wells to test the Niobrara Formation. The Crow Valley 7-62-23-2H well is located 320' FNL and 2036' FWL Section 23, Township 7 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. to bottom hole location ("BHL") 470' FSL 1988' FWL Section 23, Township 7 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. The Crow Valley 7-62-14-2H well is located 290' FNL and 2036' FWL Section 23, Township 7 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. to bottom hole location ("BHL") 470' FNL 1988' FWL Section 14, Township 7 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M.

The surface hole locations ("SHL") of Marathon's proposed horizontal wells are outside of the 318A.a. drilling window. Rule 318A.a. designates five "drilling windows" per quarter section of land in the Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) – 400'x400' boxes in the center of each quarter/quarter section, and an 800'x800' box in the center of the quarter section.

The Surface Owner has granted consent to Marathon for the requested exception to Rule 318A.a. Marathon respectfully requests approval of the exception location. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
