Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the Form 27 and Form 04s documenting the completion of remediation effort associated with the spill that occurred on Cascade Creek 620-43-32. Based on review of data presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time at the two sites referenced above. However, should future conditions at the site be discovered of contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if groundwater is found to be significantly impacted, COGCC may require that further investigation and/or remediation be conducted.
