Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the Notice of Completion Report submitted by Walter Environmental Group, Inc. for PetroHunter Operating Company on February 08, 2012 for the referenced site. Consideration was given to background arsenic concentrations. Based on review of data presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time at this site. However, should future conditions at the site be discovered of contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if groundwater is found to be significantly impacted, COGCC may require that further investigation and/or remediation be conducted.
