Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the documentation submitted by Quicksilver Resources on November 02 2011 for the referenced site. Based on review of data presented and on the inspection conducted on the same date (See NOAV # 200316003), it appears that no further action is necessary at this time at this site. However, should future conditions at the site be discovered of contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if groundwater is found to be significantly impacted, COGCC may require that further investigation and/or remediation be conducted.
