The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A (#400278115) for the Vecta Crestone 33-17 location, located in the NWSE Sec 17 T14S R47W Cheyenne County, Colorado. The COGCC requests the following changes regarding the data submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

Construction

Mud disposal is stated to be onsite land spreading; however, because the land use is range land spreading is not an accepted method of disposal. Please provide a method of mud disposal that will meet 900 series rules.

Conditions of approval

Location may be in a sensitive area due to shallow groundwater; therefore if drilling pits intercept groundwater the pit must be lined or a closed loop system used.
