Attachments required with a Subsequent Report are a wellbore diagram showing plugs that were set and casing remaining in the hole, the job summaries from all plugging contractors used, including wireline and cementing (third party verification) and any logs that may have been run during abandonment.

Technical Detail/Comments:

This well was acquired from Rosetta Resources effective 04/01/11. Rosetta Resources welded metal plate on top of casing but did not keep records of any cement work. Attached are the photos used to help determine the location was plugged.

Augustus Energy began investigating the condition and status of the well by contacting A.) Rosetta Resources prior to purchasing the well and B.) COGCC in June 2011. Rosetta Resources filed the Permit Application and nothing else. At COGCC's request Augustus Energy filed a Form 5-Completion Report (Preliminary-Surface Casing only) and Form 6-Notice of Intent to Abandon Doc # 400255101. Augustus found that remediation of the wellsite had been initiated but that no wellhead was visible. Eventually the wellhead was located below the surface, exposed, and photographed. There is no record of cement work related to plugging the well. COGCC deliberated and considers the well to be plugged and abandoned: the depth of the well, local stratigraphy, adjacent well logs, aquifers, and topography were assessed in the evaluation.
