Vicki Shelley,

I was copied with an inspection (Doc #663300229) performed at the J.A. Farms 1 (API #087-07380) on 6/26/12 by COGCC Field Engineer, Kym Schure. According to the inspection there has been a release at the wellhead exceeding 5 bbls over time that has resulted in a salt kill estimated at 4-ft by 50-ft running southwest of the wellhead. In addition, there were several other spills and related impacts documented during the inspection.

Smith Oil needs to submit a Form 19 to document the reportable release immediately. A Form 27, Site Investigation & Remediation Workplan will also be required to document cleanup of all related spills and impacts. It should also address remediation of impacts at the unlined skim pit and appropriate upgrades or closure of that pit.

The Field Inspection Unit will issue a Notice of Alleged Violation (NOAV) requiring specific corrective actions. If you need any additional guidance regarding the Form 19/27 submittals and appropriate cleanup, please give me a call.
