I have been reviewing the Wiley 32-3-97-1 Pad **Form 2A** (#400292791). COGCC would like to attach the following conditions of approval (COAs) based on the information Endeavour Operating has submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA) review.

1. **General:** The following condition of approval (COAs) will apply:
COA 44 - The access road will be constructed to prevent sediment migration from the access road to nearby surface water or any drainages leading to other nearby surface waters.

COA 38 - The moisture content of any drill cuttings in a cuttings pit, trench, or pile shall be as low as practicable to prevent accumulation of liquids greater than de minimis amounts. At the time of closure, the drill cuttings, if are to remain onsite, must also meet the applicable standards of table 910-1.

COGCC would appreciate your concurrence with attaching these COAs to the Form 2A permit prior to passing the OGLA review. In addition, could Endeavour provide COGCC with the COAs and wildlife stipulations that BLM has attached to this location.
