I have a concern about the mud or cement shooting out the surface casing as reported in the Braden head test dated 10-16-09 (see summary below). I would like to see a new or later test to see if mud or cement still shoots out as well as the results of the overall test. Based on the later or newer results, I may want to speak with a production engineer and discuss possible remedial work options.
