Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the update Report (Form 27) including analytical data, the request for NFA, and additional documents submitted by XTO on July 10, 2012, for the referenced site. Based on review of data presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time at this site. However, should future conditions at the site be discovered of contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if groundwater is found to be significantly impacted, COGCC may require that further investigation and/or remediation be conducted.
