Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the Form 27 and Form 04s documenting the completion of the CC Pond 11 pit closure. These documents were submitted by Walsh on behalf of OXY USA. Based on review of data presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time at the two sites referenced above. However, should future conditions at the site be discovered of contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if groundwater is found to be significantly impacted, COGCC may require that further investigation and/or remediation be conducted.

The remediation project will be closed in COGCC database with a Form 27A. The status of the pit was changed to closed (CL) in the scout card. If you require any additional information, please call me at (970) 625-2497.
