Pond 11 Pit Closure Work Plan was received on 10/12/2011, and approved/entered in the database on 10/14/2011 (**REM # 6363**). COGCC expected to be notified of the pit closure by means of a Notice of Completion (NOC), in order to close the project and issue a NFA letter. The NOC to be submitted by OXY should include the confirmation analyses and a brief description of the pit closure and reclamation activities.

Here is an extract of the Form 27 submitted:

- OXY IS PROPOSING THE CLOSURE OF THE EXISTING STORAGE POND. OXY WILL REMOVE ALL ABOVE-LINER FLUIDS AND SOLIDS FORM THE PIT AND WILL REINTRODUCE INTO OXY'S FLUID SYSTEM OR DISPOSED OF AT A PERMITTED DISPOSAL FACILITY. LINERS WILL BE SAMPLED THEN REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF AT A PERMITTED DISPOSA FACILITY.
SAMPLES WILL BE COLLECTED FROM THE PIT BOTTOM FOLLOWING REMOVAL OF THE PIT LINER AND WILL BE ANALYZED FOR COMPLAINEE WITH COGCC TABLE 910-1
- THE IMPRESSION FOR THE BACKFILLED PIT OCCURS WITHIN THE PAD BOUNDARY FOR THIS LOCATION. **DURING INTERIM RECLAMATION** THE BACKFILLED PIT MAY BE PART OF THE PAD'S WORKING SURFACE; THEREFORE, **THE PIT WILL BE RECONTOURED LEVEL WITH THE PAD SURFACE.**

Please submit a brief letter (Notice of Completion) including the confirmation sampling results, and a brief description of the pit closure and interim reclamation. I will close the project as soon as we receive the NOC.

Note: Please include the pit closure remediation number (REM # 6363) in all communications

related to this project.
