I appreciate your help in clarifying and expanding on the goals of the BMPs and Gulfport agrees but would like to have section (2) match the wording of the Ridgeview site if we may. It simply codifies the conversations we had about necessary operations and the need on our part to inform. It was submitted by the CPW as an attachment to the approved Ridgeview APD 2A as follows:

2) Restrict post-development well site visitations between the hours of 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM and reduce well site visitations between December 1 and April 15 in elk winter concentration areas; emergency, unusual, or necessary maintenance situations are exempt; however prior notification to COGCC and CPW is required detailing the needed work and estimated schedule.

Listed below are CPWs recommended BMPs for the proposed Sandrock 33-14-1 location.

Pad location: **Sandrock 33-14-1, T 6 N, R 91 W, section 14 at 40.476850, -107.568050, State Land Board surface and minerals.**

Document #: **400308491**

Wildlife concerns: The proposed pad location is within Elk Winter Concentration area (a sensitive wildlife areas), and is also within Preliminary General Habitat of greater sage-grouse. Based on the above wildlife concerns, CPW recommends the following BMPs:

1. Where oil and gas activities must occur in elk winter concentration areas, conduct these activities outside the time period from December 1 through April 15.
2. Restrict post-development well site visitations to between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. and reduce well site visitations between December 1 and April 15 in elk winter concentration areas.
3. Avoid aggressive non-native grasses and shrubs in elk habitat restoration.
4. Reclaim elk habitats with native shrubs, grasses, and forbs appropriate to the ecological site disturbed.
5. State Land Board District Manager must approve the reclamation seed mix
6. Close and immediately reclaim all roads that are redundant, not used regularly, or have been abandoned to the maximum extent possible to minimize disturbance and habitat fragmentation.
7. Establish company guidelines to minimize wildlife mortality from vehicle collisions on private roads.

8. Install and utilize bear-proof dumpsters and trash receptacles for all food-related trash on location, following COGCC Rule 1204 a-1.

CPW would appreciate your concurrence with the proposed BMP's. Form 2A comments for this location are due on September 12. Please let me know if you have questions.
